SCHOLARSHIPS

Sacred Heart College offers a limited number of scholarships to Grade 8 learners each year. Our scholarships range from partial to full scholarships and are awarded for the duration of the learners stay at Sacred Heart College. Please be aware that there are a few provisos to the continuation of the scholarship from year to year. These depend on the nature of the scholarship awarded. The scholarship does not include school levies, textbooks, stationery or the cost of extra options such as camps or travel tours

1. ACTIVE CITIZEN SCHOLARSHIP

The Active Citizen Scholarship is intent on finding generous, caring young people who make a meaningful contribution to improving the lives of people around them. Community involvement, time to take care of other people, involvement in environmental activism are some of the ways that active citizenry might be manifest.

To qualify, the candidate must be able to prove active citizenship in any form and to demonstrate courage, stamina, a sense of justice and a willingness to share and learn.

Requirements: Together with your completed application, write one page about how through your actions you have been active in your community to improve the lives of others. Describe what it is that you have been doing or done and how it demonstrates your commitment to your community. List the names of any organisations, groups or people that are relevant to your application and include a letter of reference which reflects your involvement in your community. Please include your reasons for doing this work and how it makes you feel. Tell us why you think you deserve this scholarship and provide any other information you think is important.

Requirements: Together with your completed application, include a letter from your parish priest and list the parish committee or work that you are involved in.

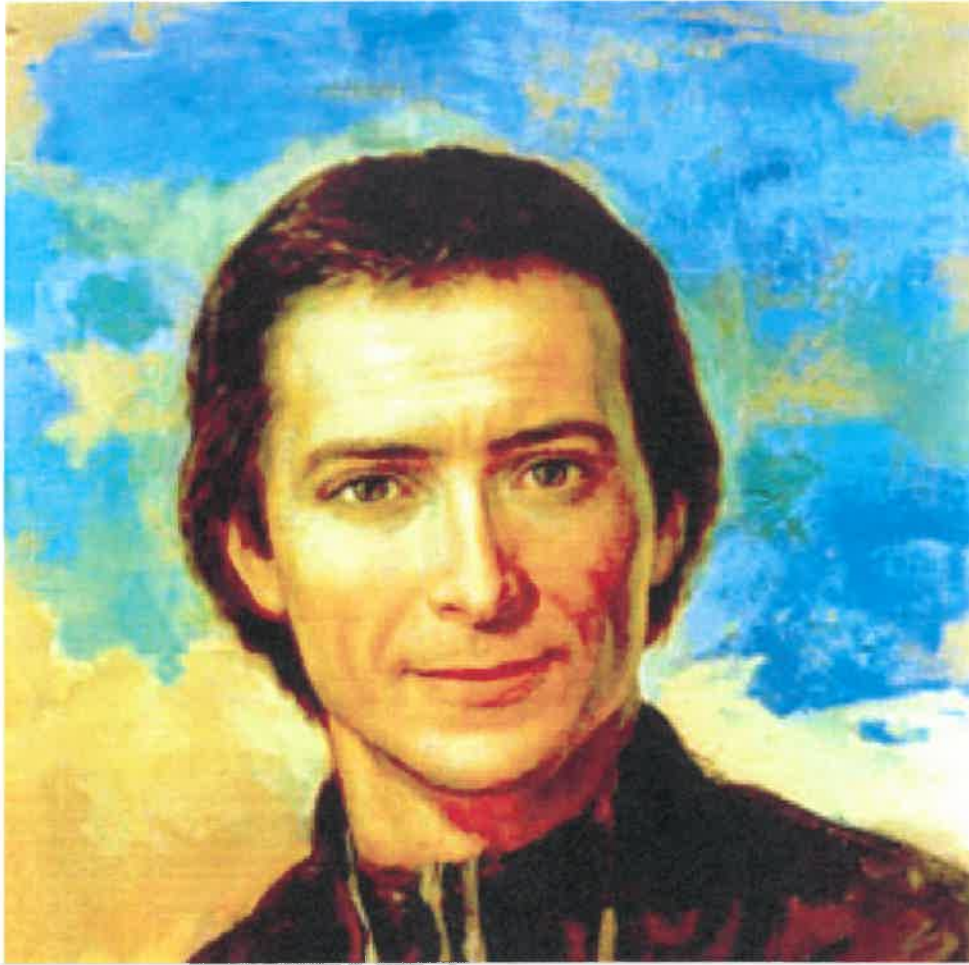
