Terms and Conditions:

Applications for the partial scholarship programme will be considered on the following basis:

a) completion of the scholarship application form supported by a letter of motivation from the student's parents.

b) students wanting to apply for any of the limited places will be required to select a scholarship and upload the information on the contribution they intend to make to strengthen and reflect our ethos and value system at Sacred Heart College in their area of excellence/ achievement.

c) completion by parents of a 'means test' to assess the level of scholarship that the school will provide given that it is not 100%. In the case of current parents the fees must also be up to date.

d) completion of a baseline assessment to establish the level of academic intervention that may be required given learning losses caused by the impact of COVID-19 on the potential student, if the student is not applying for the academic scholarship.

e) an interview with the parents and the student with members of the Sacred Heart College teaching staff.

All applications under the 'Partial Scholarship Programme' open on 6 August 2021 and will close on 15 September 2021. Due to the **LIMITED** number of places being made available under the programme, parents and students are encouraged to submit their applications as soon as possible.
