



GRADE 4 TO 10 SCHOLARSHIPS

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE SHC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME AND WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT WHEN APPLYING:

Sacred Heart College is offering a limited number of students the opportunity to apply for a place at our school on a partial scholarship basis. **These scholarships range from 15-50% of our current fees and are applicable to Grades 4 – 10.** Please be aware that there are a few provisos to the continuation of the scholarship from year to year. These depend on the nature of the scholarship awarded. The scholarship does not include school levies, textbooks, stationery or the cost of extra options such as camps or travel tours. Submitting an application does NOT guarantee an interview. Similarly, an interview does not guarantee a scholarship.

Sacred Heart College awards 4 types of Scholarships:

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

- The Academic Scholarship is awarded to students who have excelled academically and are among the top achievers at their school. This scholarship aims to recognise those students who are academically talented and would make a contribution to a rich history of academic excellence.

OR

THE ACTIVE CITIZEN

- The Active Citizen Scholarship looks for generous, caring young people who make a meaningful contribution to improving the lives of people around them. Community involvement through self-initiated projects, participation in community-driven projects, and involvement in gender and environmental activism are examples of ways that active citizens make a difference in their community.

OR

CREATIVE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

- This Scholarship is awarded to students who have excelled in either Music, Art or Drama at their school. This scholarship aims to recognise those students who are creatively talented and would contribute to a rich history of creative excellence.

OR

SPORTS

This Scholarship is awarded to students who have excelled on the sports field particularly in the fields of girls' and boys' soccer; girls and boys basketball; girls and boys swimming and girls and boys cricket. This scholarship aims to assist a student who is a talented sports person who would make a contribution to a rich history of sporting excellence as they develop their sporting talent.

In determining the extent of the scholarship, consideration will be given to the following:

Grades 4 to 10, 2023 Scholarship Applications:

Grades 4 to 10 scholarship applications are open (closing **30 JULY 2022**).



- Scholarship applications can be made via the online form; you can download the form and email it back to the school; or you can pick up hard copies from main reception and return them to the school.
- Scholarship applications **do not** attract the general R450 application fee.
- Should the applicant be unsuccessful in their application but would like to continue with the general application process, only then will the R450 fee be applied and a general application will need to be completed – **please do not complete this step unless advised.**
- Scholarships may be withdrawn if the remainder of the school fees and charges are not kept up to date.
- Should a scholarship recipient leave Sacred Heart College during an academic year in order to take up a position at another school, the parents may be held responsible for the full, undiscounted school fees for one term as notice.
- **Sacred Heart College is not a Boarding School.**

PLEASE NOTE: YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED TIMEOUSLY FOR YOU TO BE CONSIDERED.

In compliance with the PoPI Act, all your information will be kept strictly confidential and secure. Should your application be unsuccessful, any and all information given to us, will be deleted after a period of six months. By accessing, using and/or interacting with Sacred Heart College via its online and/or electronic platforms such as this application, you consent to the processing of your personal information by Sacred Heart College.
